

.CO Overview



.CO Internet became the new Administrator of the .CO domain in Feb/2010. Since then:

- 1. Transitioned administration of Registry, DNS, and related systems
- 2. Launched with 10 registrars
- 3. Gradual offering plan (Grandfathering, Sunrise, Landrush, GA) for the 2nd level .CO
- 4. General Availability on July 20th 2010
- 5. 233,000 domains first 24 hours, currently at 612,000 domains

DNSSEC Implementation Plan



.CO has begun the deployment of DNSSEC and expects to have it live by end of Q1/11

- 1. OTE for registrars to do EPP testing ongoing
- 2. Signing of zone 2nd week in February/2010
- 3. Root update with IANA 2nd/3rd week in February/2010
- 4. Zone burn-in period 3rd and 4th week in February/2010
- 5. Go live enable DNSSEC in the Production EPP environment during the 3rd week of March/2010

DNSSEC Deployment



.CO has begun the deployment of DNSSEC following the same model .biz and .us are using through Neustar as our technology partner

- NSEC just as in .biz and .us
- Signatures generated with RSA/SHA-256
- No certification required for registrars
- No restrictions on transfers
- Whois will not indicate if a domain is signed.
- Key Signing Keys (KSKs) rolled over annually
- Zone Signing Keys (ZSKs) rolled over monthly
